1936

- **Borg – Warner Trophy.** The Borg – Warner Trophy “will supplant the famous Wheeler – Schebler Trophy”. Each year the winning face will be added to the trophy.

 - 1954 Indianapolis 500 winner's painting was unfinished and in sketch form when presented to Bill Vukovich

1955 – 1971

- L. Strauss Trophy (Bronze & Black Marble Clock), winner of the race

1988 Borg – Warner awarded “Baby Borg Trophies” to race winner (14 inch sterling silver replica)
