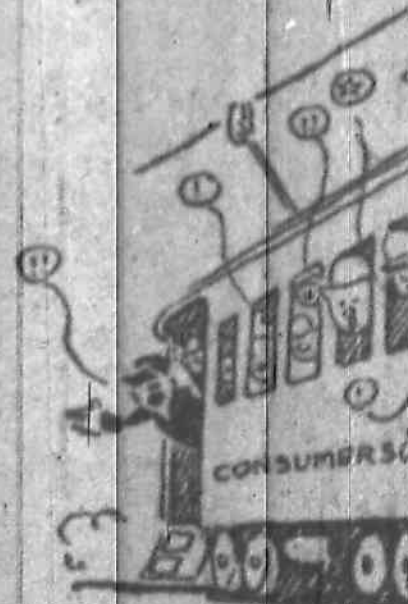
AITKEN POSTS NEW FIGURE

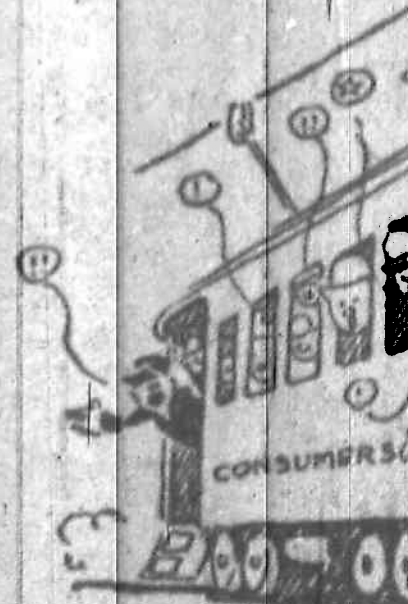

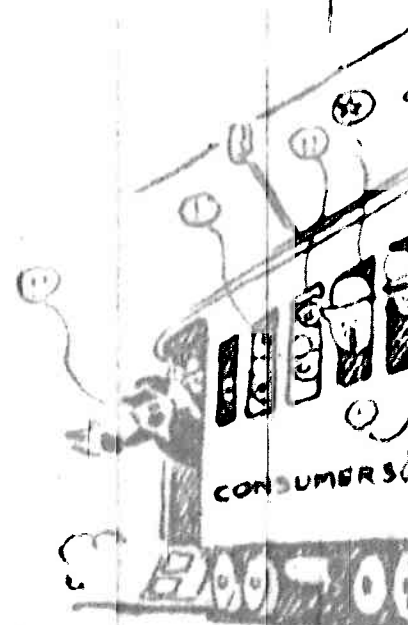
