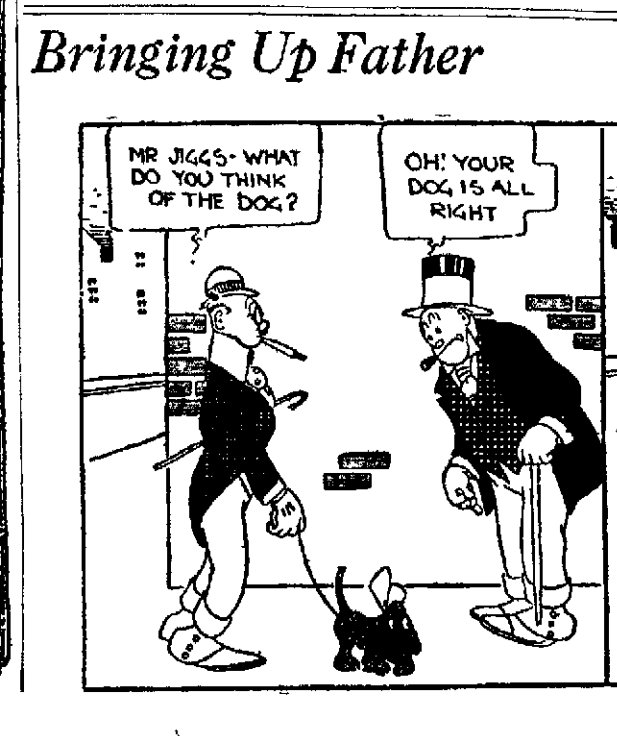

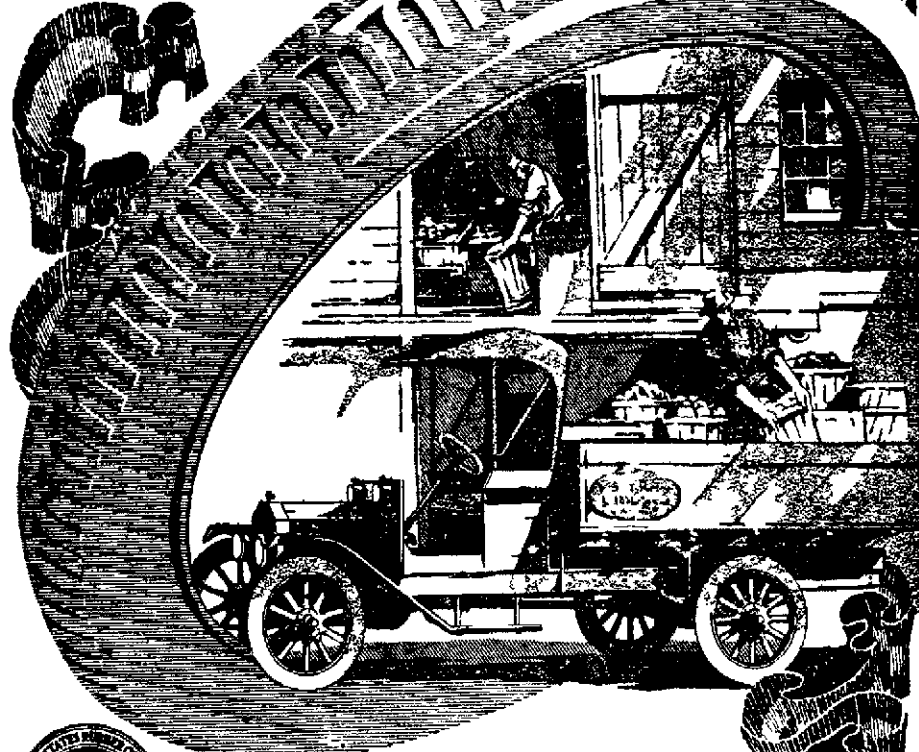
ELKS Flag Day Services

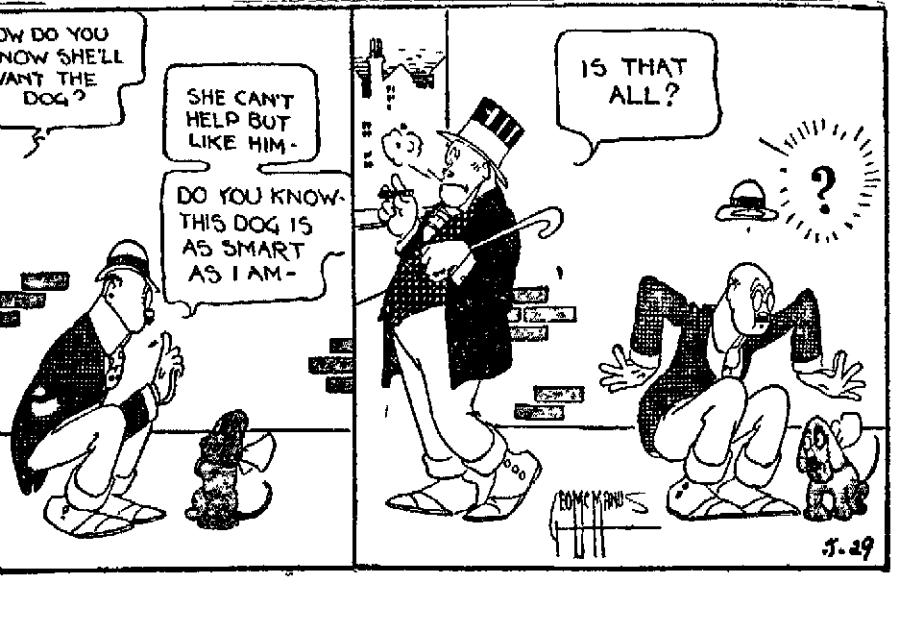
