

WILL BUILD SWIFT AUTOS

KULICK'S NARROW ESCAPE ACTS AS ONLY TEMPORARY CHECK ON MO-TORIST'S DESIRE TO SEE HIS MACHINES "SPIN."

Henry Ford, America's wizard of the automobile industry, promises to again build a racing car that will attract the same attention as did the old 999 with which Barney Oldfield established his reputation as the world's premier track driver.

Speaking of racing cars, at the Cobe trophy race a few days ago, Ford said: "I feel that I will have to enter the racing game again. I thought I was through with it a couple of years ago, when Frank Kulick, driving the big racer that I designed for him, crashed through the fence at the fairgrounds track at Detroit, while traveling at a rate of speed that has never been equaled on a circular mile track. This accident almost proved fatal to Kulick; in fact it has left him with a noticeable limp and he was laid up for almost a year after it happened. I have always been satisfied that the car would be a record breaker, but after that accident I bade the racing game, at which my design of machine has always been such a success, a sad farewell. Kulick has also been content to leave it a closed book in so far as referring to it again has occurred. But the Indianapolis Mo-


