

FRONTENAC MOTORS ENTERS BANKRUPTCY

Indianapolis, Ind., April 14.—The Frontenac Motor Company today filed a voluntary petition in bankruptcy in United States District Court listing its assets at \$425 and its liabilities at \$88,163.56.

The petition was signed by Louis Chevrolet, a former race driver, as president of the company. Allen A. Ryan was the first president of the company when it was organized a year ago to manufacture a car designed by Chevrolet.
