

# Escapes When Mechanician Is Killed.

Arthur Greiner, the former amateur pilot who won fame with a National, was injured when the Amplex (44) threw a tire in the thirteenth lap on the south turn and his mechanic, Dickson, was killed. Greiner had expected to drive a Fal car in the big race, and when the Chicago cars did not come Greiner took a position with the Amplex. Greiner's car was the same car with which Gaston Morris, the French

driver, hit the wall a week ago last Sunday, and then the Frenchman refused to drive the car at any price. This was not the car in which Joe Horan met with an accident in practice. Greiner had held the car to the track with seeming ease and had prepared for the race by tanning his hands with a chemical solution to make them like leather. That he held the car was shown by the distance that he held it to the track after throwing the tire.
