Jacobus, a civil engineer, who has been identified with the Pennsylvania tunnel development, and many projects for utilizing the Hackensack Meadows lands, has obtained four hundred acres of land on the Hackensack Meadows lying between the Newark plant road and the Pennsylvania railroad tracks, over which it is proposed to build the park.
