KNOXVILLE, Tenn., June 8.—Driving a 30-horsepower stock car, Hamton A. Harth, a local amateur, yesterday afternoon smashed the world's record for a mile on a half-mile track, unbanked turns, making the distance in 1:19, clipping half a second off the record. The record was made at a meeting called for the purpose of breaking the mile and five-mile records. Cantrell, a professional, using the same car used by Harth, attempted to lower Harth's record, but the best he could do was 1:21.

BADGERS WILL GO TO JAPAN

Faculty Consents to Trip of Baseball Team to Orient.

MADISON, Wis., June 8.—The Wisconsin university faculty voted unanimously last night to send the baseball nine to Japan for a twelve-game series with Kelo university, of Tokyo, in September. Charles McCarthy, former assistant football coach, will accompany the team as faculty representative. The players must be bonafide students in the university, with the usual requirement as to scholastic standing. The conference three-year rule will not apply. The team will not be picked until after examinations, when arrangements will be made for summer practice. The first game is scheduled for September 16, and players must be back by November 2.
