Heretofore Apperson cars have competed on the Pacific coast only in the annual Alameda-San Jose hill-climb, which has been won during the last two years by Edgar Apperson in his Jack Rabbit.

Tom T. Shetterly of Los Angeles, the Apperson dealer for southern California, has purchased an Apperson Jack Rabbit for the first big road race to be held on the coast on the Santa Monica course July 10.


**Western Autoists Pay

Shettler has nominated Harris M. Han-
 shue as driver, and the latter is now at
 the Apperson factory overseeing the build-
 ing of his car.

Hanshue is 27 years old, weighs 200
 pounds and is 5 feet 9 inches tall. He
 has been engaged in the automobile busi-
 ness for eight years, one year in East-
 Lansing, Mich., and seven years in California.
 Since 1903 he has driven in all kinds of
 competitions, such as track and road
 races, including the famous Mt. Baldy
 road race and the race from Los Angeles,
 Cal., to Phoenix, Ariz., 500 miles across
 mountain and desert roads. His best
 track record is 51.45 seconds for a mile
 on a circular horse track.

Hanshue will also drive the Apperson
 in the Mt. Baldy 100-mile road race in
 September and in the Los Angeles to
 Phoenix race in November next. It is
 probable that the Phoenix people will offer
 a cash prize of \$1,000 to the driver of the
 first car to reach that city. Hanshue
 says he is going after the money.

He will remain East until after the In-
 dian road race on June 18 and 19, and
 will meet his car in Los Angeles about
 June 20.
