DONOR OF TROPHY PROMISES INDIAN-
APOLIS PROMOTERS SUPPORT IN
THEIR QUEST FOR CLASSIC RACE
ON INDIANA COURSE.

CHICAGO, April 25.—(Special)—Ira M.
Cobe, donator of the Cobe trophy, which
was raced for over the Crownpoint course,
favors the holding of this event at the
Indianapolis Motor Speedway July 4. This
practically concedes another plum to In-
diana.

E. A. Moross, director of contests for
the Speedway, visited Mr. Cobe in Chi-
cago today, and after a conference, the
matter was taken up with Mr. Joseph F.
Gunther, chairman of the contest board
of the Chicago Automobile Club. Mr.
Gunther gave his approval to the Motor
Speedway proposition, which means that
the event will be managed by the Auto-
mobile Club of Chicago and promoted by
the Motor Speedway.

The Cobe Trophy, to be the last event
on the program July 4, the distance to be
decided later, but presumably 200 miles,
for cars of classes 4 and 5, 301 to 600
cubic inches piston displacement. A final
meeting to decide the matter with the ap-
proval of Mr. Cobe and Mr. Gunther, will
be placed before the board of directors of
the Chicago Automobile Club next Mon-
day.

At a conference with the Chicago Motor
Club Mr. Moross was advised that the
Cobe trophy event may be run over the
Elgin course. In case the event is not
known as the Elgin trophy it will be for
the Cobe trophy, in which case the In-
dianapolis Motor Speedway management
is willing to waive its negotiations for
the Cobe in favor of the Chicago Motor
Club.

In the event of the race going to the
Speedway it will give Indianapolis the
combined support of both organizations,
which will tend to make the Cobe one of
the classics of 1910. The final decision
of the Chicago Motor Club will be given
next Friday.
