EASTERN ENTRY RECEIVED

LOZIER MACHINE WILL RACE

CAR WHICH HAS MADE EXCELLENT
SHOWING IN VARIOUS SPEED CON-
TESTS WILL STRIVE FOR HON-
ORS AT SPEEDWAY.

The first Eastern car to enter the
Speedway races was received yesterday
when the Lozier sent in blanks. The
Lozier is perhaps one of the best known
Eastern racing cars. This car has made
a fine showing in most of the important
events held on this continent.

It won one of the greatest twenty-four
hour event ever run at Brighton Beach
and performed with credit in the Briar-
cliffe and Savannah road events.

Both four and six-cylinder cars of the
Eastern firm will take part in events for
the Indianapolis Motor Speedway trophy.
The cost of the Speedway complete,
which was reckoned at \$350,000, is being
exceeded. With the laying of a rock-sur-
faced track, the cost has exceeded the first
figures by \$40,000, so that the plant when
completed will be close to \$390,000.

A car tuned for racing is only prepared
at great expense. The parts must be
carefully selected or prepared to give the
best results. However, many of the cars
will cost less than \$8,000 in the small
races, while most of them entered will run
well above that price. Special cars, such
as the Fiat, the Benz, the Christie and
Darracq, as well as many others, will cost
as high as \$15,000, in some instances \$20,-
000.

Three thousand dollars each for the cars
entered at the Speedway would indeed be
a conservative estimate, while 100 en-
tries for all the events of the three days
of the meet will be placing the list at its
lowest.
