EASTERN RACING CARS AFTER SPEEDWAY HONOR

LOZIER AND KNOX SEND IN
ENTRY BLANKS.

FAMOUS DRIVERS COMING

Some idea of the importance that will be attached to the races at the Indianapolis motor speedway next month may be gained in entry blanks just received from two of the greatest racing teams in the country. The first eastern entry, that of the Lozier, received yesterday, was followed today when entry blanks were received from the famous Knox team, Bourque and Dennison. The Knox is also an eastern car, being made at Springfield, Mass.

Both the Lozier and Knox have been leading factors in almost all the important speed events in the country. The Lozier won one of the greatest twenty-four-hour events ever run at Brighton beach and was also well up at the finish in the Briarcliff and Savannah road events. During the recent Crown Point-Lowell

races Dennison in his Knox was one of the strongest competitors for the Cobe trophy. He piloted his car into the lead and held it almost until the finish. The Knox team is entered in event S on Saturday, August 21, for the Wheeler and Schebler trophy and will also compete for the Prest-O-Lite trophy on Friday. Both cars will also be driven in many of the minor races. The Lozier team will also compete in both trophy events.

Famous Fiat May be Seen.

The management of the speedway is in receipt of a letter from E. R. Hollander, the foreign import agent for the United States for the famous Fiat car. He states that it is his desire to have the car he represents, and which was driven by Nazario over the Brooklands track a mile at the rate of 121 1/2 per hour, in Indianapolis during the races.

The car will be shipped from Europe early in August, and it is expected to travel at the rate of two miles a minute at the Indianapolis track during the meet in August. There will be at least six events in which the monster racing car of Nazario can compete, as well as events in which the stock cars of the company will be eligible. Eddie Horn, the young millionaire of Chicago, has entered his Fiat, that he drove in the Crown Point races, at the local meet, while the entry of Ralph De Palma is also expected.

Other entries now at hand are those of the National and Apperson. Barney Oldfield will pilot the former, while Herb Little and Harris Hanchos will be seen at the wheels of Appersons. Hanchos has just added to his reputation by winning the great Los Angeles road race, a big event on the coast.

Motorcycle Run to Kokomo.

During the week of the national motorcycle meet to be held in Indianapolis, starting August 2, an invitation pleasure-run will take place, from Indianapolis to Kokomo and return, a distance of fifty miles each way. This feature of the week's pleasure will be known as the Kokomo run, and will be held by invitation of the Kokomo Rubber Company, which will provide a banquet for the boys at the Country Club at Kokomo and will further present to each rider making the trip a beautiful souvenir medallion showing the imprint of "Chief Kokomo," which will be a pleasant reminder of one of the happy days spent during the national F. A. M. meet.
