Coroner Examines Witnesses as to Death of Holcomb and Borque.

Five witnesses were examined this afternoon by Coroner Blackwell in the investigation of the death of Harry Holcomb and William Borque, who were killed in the automobile accident at the motor speedway on Thursday. All testified as to the rough condition of the track and that the low place where the tiling was placed was responsible for the accident. Those who testified today were: Francis E. Haugh, 624 West Tenth street; Frank Brandon, 139 North Delaware street; Reno Harbe, 430 East Michigan street, all soldiers; Albert Spieger, a chauffeur, of Kansas City, and John P. Weaver, a special policeman, living at 2506 Walker street.

Walter F. Wood Seeks to Put Every One in Sullivan Co. Out of Business.
