INDIANAPOLIS TO REGAIN AUTO RECORDS NOW LOST

NEW BRICK SPEEDWAY WILL BE FASTEST IN WORLD.

WORLD MARKS AT ATLANTA

(By Carburator.)

Indianapolis motor experts who watched the many world's records established this summer at the Indianapolis motor speedway fall by the wayside during the running of the opening races at the new automobile course at Atlanta yesterday are slow to believe that the southern track is faster than the one here. The two courses have attracted the attention of automobilists everywhere from the fact that they are the first to be constructed exclusively for motor racing and also from the fact that they were constructed along the same lines. Much discussion had arisen prior to yesterday as to which was the faster.

During the running of the Indianapolis races many drivers maintained that faster time could have been made, except for the bumpy condition of the track. The time established at Atlanta yesterday serves to bear out this theory and also furnishes evidence of a fitness that had not been developed at the Indianapolis course.
