CHICAGO, May 17.—Fire losses, ex-
 cluding forest and marine, aggregate
 \$456,000,000 a year in the United States,
 according to C. M. Goddard, president of
 the National Fire Protective Association,
 which began its fourteenth annual meet-
 ing here today.

Oldfield Not Decided on Speedway Entries

KANSAS CITY, Mo., May 17.—Barney
 Oldfield stated today there is no truth in
 the story wired from Indianapolis Sat-
 urday, to the effect that he had demanded
 a bonus of \$5,000 to appear at the Indian-
 apolis Speedway meet May 27-30.

"I paid \$14,000 for my new car," said
 Oldfield, "and hold the world's speed rec-
 ord with it. I have sent it on two speed-
 ways over three seconds faster to the
 mile than the record for the Indianapolis
 Speedway. I wrote the Indianapolis pro-
 moters asking them to put up adequate
 prizes for such records as I might break
 there. They hung up liberal purses for
 stock cars, but practically nothing for me
 or my car to win."

Oldfield left for Chicago last night,
 shipping his racing cars in an express
 car to the Windy City.
