He stopped off here while en route to Florda, where he will participate in the Daytona Beach races. While here he was the guest of the Buick-Losey Company and in company with Mr. Losey went over the grounds of the speedway and discussed the plans with the engineers. Strang is the only American racing driver who has been on the famous irrooklands in England, and because of his wide racing experience in this country and Europe he is exceptionally well posted on tracks and road courses.

Looks for Records.

He is of the opinion that the local track when completed will be capable of standing terrific speed and predicts that the Brookland's records will be smashed here within the first year. Strang, Louis thevrolet and Bob Burman will form the Buick racing team this year. Cheyrolet, who is a noted French driver, drove Flat for years and is best remembered n this country as the man who defeated Barney Oldfield in the ten out of elevenaces in 1905. Burman was the winner the 100-mile championship race at New Orleans recently.

Strang states that it is the intention of the Buick Motor Company to enter the full team in all events to which its stock and special racing cars are eligi-ble and that all three would be seen here on the occasion of the first meet at the
