ST. LOUIS ASKS FOR INTERNATIONAL AVIATION MEET.

A DECISION NEXT MONTH

ST. LOUIS, January 29.—Preliminary to a meeting here, late today, at which it was expected a federation of aero clubs would be formed, Cortlandt F. Bishop, president of the Aero Club of America, and local aeronauts inspected sites suitable for aeroplane flights.

The Aero Club of St. Louis impressed Mr. Bishop that it wanted the international balloon flight and the international aviation contest. A definite decision will not be rendered by Mr. Bishop, however, until in February.

Nine aero clubs were expected to be represented in the conference of the aeronauts. These included the Aero Clubs of America, Pennsylvania, Indiana, New England, Rochester and Des Moines, the Aircraft Club of Peoria, the Kansas City Aero Club and the Aero Club of St. Louis.

They will offer a guarantee of \$75,000 and a percentage of the gate receipts. Indianapolis is the only city with enclosed aviation grounds, and Fisher and Moross assert that the Indianapolis receipts would be greater than any specified amount any city in the country can offer. The Indianapolis promoters are also after the international balloon race and other attractions.
