They hung bunched throughout the trial and at the finish there was not 40 feet between the first and the fifth car.

However, Kincald, driving a National, pushed the nose of his car over the line about 18 inches abead of the second car, a Marmon, driven by Dawson. The prize was \$100 in gold to the winner and \$60 in silver for the second man. The time was 4:5:76, which lowers the record for five miles by 40 seconds.
