

The Indianapolis motor speedway trophy, the prize for the winner of the 300-mile race for high-powered stock cars on the new motor speedway, four miles west of Indianapolis, is the most valuable ever hung up for an automobile speed contest. It is of solid silver and is valued at \$10,000. The race for this trophy will be held on the last day of the three-day August automobile race meeting at the speedway, August 21. F. H. Wheeler and G. M. Schebler, of the Wheeler-Schebler Carburetor Company, are the donors of the trophy.

Official Program for First Auto Races on New Indianapolis Motor Speedway

Date—Thursday, Friday and Saturday, August 19, 20 and 21.

THURSDAY.

- Event No. 1—Two hundred miles; for the Prest-O-Lite trophy.
- Event No. 2—Five miles; stripped chassis cars; Class 4; 161 to 230 cubic inches.
- Event No. 3—Ten miles; stripped chassis cars; Class 3; 231 to 300 cubic inches.
- Event No. 4—Five miles; stripped chassis cars; Class 2; 301 to 450 cubic inches.
- Event No. 5—Ten-mile free-for-all handicap; open to all cars entered at this meet. Cars will be handicapped in accordance with their performances at this meet by the board of official handicappers.

FRIDAY.

- Event No. 6—Five miles; stripped chassis cars; Class 3; 231 to 300 cubic inches.
- Event No. 7—Ten miles; stripped chassis cars; Class 2; 301 to 450 cubic inches.
- Event No. 8—Record trials to lower world's records for track. Each car will be permitted to make two attempts, electrically timed.
- Event No. 9—Ten miles for cars of Class 1, entered Saturday, up to 600 inches.
- Event No. 10—Fifty miles; for cars of Class 4; stripped chassis; 161 to 230 inches.
- Event No. 11—Five miles; free-for-all handicap; open to all cars entered in meet. Cars will be handicapped by official handicapper in accordance with their performances at this meet.

Event No. 1—The national trophy.

SATURDAY.

- Event No. 12—Record trials up to ten miles. Free for all cars.
- Event No. 13—Free-for-all handicap race. Open to all cars entered at this meet. Cars will be handicapped according to their performances.
- Event No. 14—Five-mile consolation. Open to all cars that have not won a first prize at this meet.
- Event No. 15—Twenty-five-mile free-for-all race. Open to all cars.
- Event No. 1—Indianapolis motor speedway trophy for the most valuable trophy in the world; 300 miles.
