

# FLAG-TO-FLAG CAR WILL TRY FOR INDIANA TROPHY

AUTO IN RECENT PATHFINDING  
EXPEDITION NOMINATED.

ENTRY LIST NOW COMPLETE

The successful finish of the recent flag to flag trail blazing expedition of the Chalmers-Detroit from Denver to the City of Mexico added one more entry to the Indiana trophy road race of the Chicago Automobile Club set for June 18. The belated nomination came to hand yesterday, it being that of a third Chalmers-Detroit for the light car race—William Knipper of flag to flag fame was nominated as driver. At the same time the company announced that Joe Matson will pilot the second Chalmers and Al Poole the first one named.

This was an unexpected boost for the entry list and raises the grand total to twenty-nine for the two events, seventeen of which are in the curtain raiser, which now includes a Moon, three Buicks, three Chalmers-Detroits, two Stoddard-Daytons, two Marions, two Locomobiles, a Renault, a Ford, a Fal-car, and a Corbin. In the other race there are twelve cars—three Buicks, two Stoddards, two Knoxes, two Locomobiles, a Fiat, and a pair of Appersons.

The first contingent of brack eastern drivers arrived yesterday at Crown Point, although they will not be able to get on the course for several days. The trio that reported are part of the Locomobile
