MRS. LOTZ GETS DIVORCE.

Decree is Granted Muncie Woman on
Her Cross-Complaint.

MUNCIE, Ind., August 10.—A divorce was granted Mrs. Walter J. Lotz, wife of the Democratic candidate for attorney general last fall, also the candidate two years prior to that time, last night on her cross-complaint. Lotz had filed the original complaint for a divorce, but he made no serious objection to his wife's obtaining the decree when she consented to eliminate sensational charges which she had publicly made and merely preferred the statutory charge of cruel and inhuman treatment and cited instances to bear out her allegations. Lotz's attorneys were in the courtroom, prepared to contest any charges not agreeable to the husband in the case.
