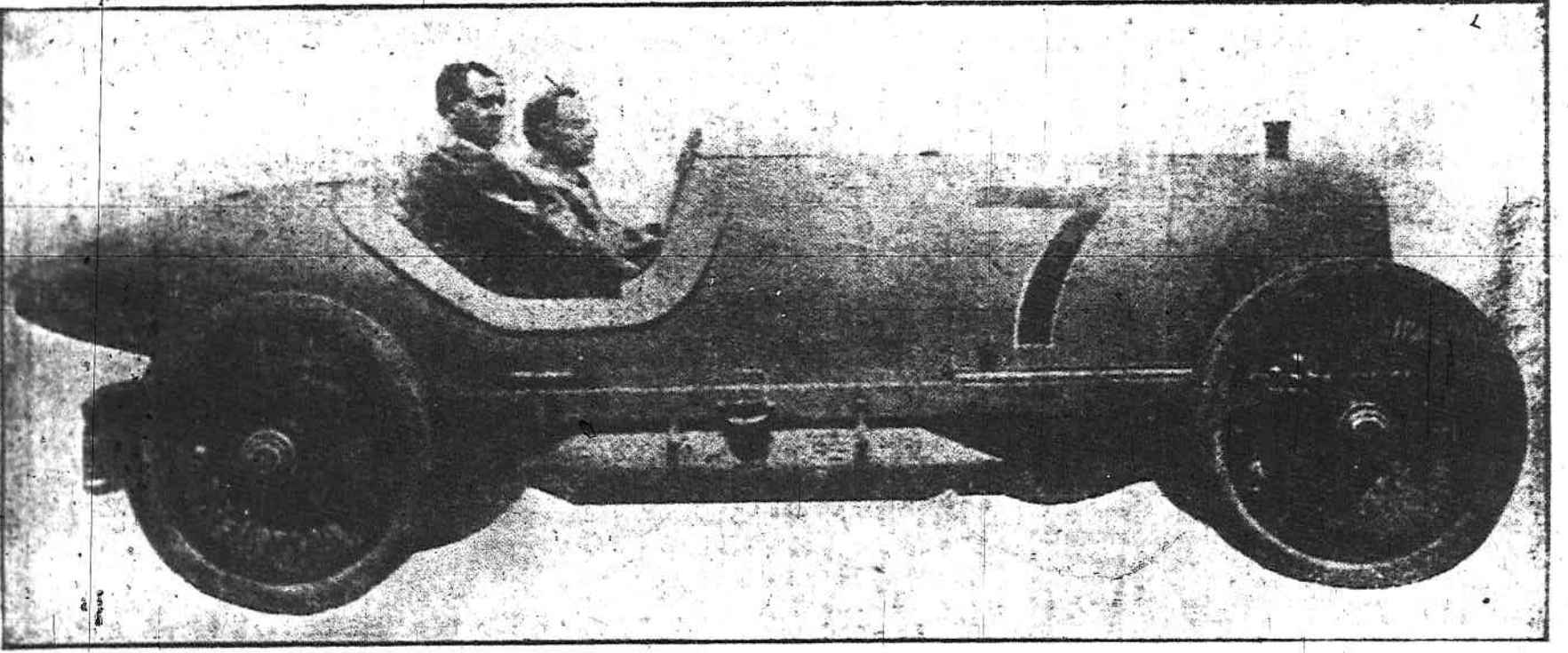

Altogether the trimmest craft yet to arrive on the speedway is the Delta, seen in the above picture, with its builder and designer, E. H. Delling, a consulting automobile engineer, of Brooklyn, N. Y., at the wheel, and his mechanic, Max Mattie, at his side. From radiator to tail lamp it presents nothing but a

smooth succession of harmonious curves, gently sloping from front to back, stream like fashion, on the model of a perfect cigar. Even the Sunbeam, noted for the grace of its outlines, has nothing on this newest of racing creations. The design, in toto, is due to Delling himself. This is by no means the first fast car he has ever built, the little Mercer, which Hughes drove last year, generally being credited to his ingenuity. When the performance

of that little boat is taken into consideration, it will easily be seen that the Delta, its successor, will have to be figured with during the coming contest. What it can actually deliver it was impossible to determine yesterday, because of the heavy rain which prevented it from taking the course.
