

# TWENTY-EIGHT ENTRIES TO DATE AT SPEEDWAY

THREE CASE CARS AND A MERCEDES ADDED TO LIST.

OTHERS ARE EXPECTED SOON

True to expectations, the day prior to the closing of the speedway entry list was marked by a veritable flood of contestants, with more expected by each mail. Three Case cars and the Schroeder-Mercedes which DePalma drove last year, were thus registered by wire yesterday. The former were sent in by J. Alex Sloan from Taylor, Tex., where they are being barnstormed; the latter by Schroeder himself, from New York city. Diabrow, Nikrent and Wild Bill Endicott will pilot the Case machines, while Ralph Mulford will tool the Mercedes.

The total number of entries to date is twenty-eight. Only two more places remain, therefore, to fill the speedway complement. If more cars than thirty register an elimination series will prove necessary to cut them down to the proper number. In view of the present rush to get in under the wire it is held that this preliminary test will quit likely prove necessary. Machines yet to be heard from are the special which Eddie Hearne is said to be constructing, the Clement-Talbot, which a group of New Yorkers has been dickering for, and the Napier, which Rupert Jenkins said he would nominate.
