## Speedway Helmet Is Older Than Auto Came

How the speedway helmet, now commonly worn by Bob Burman and other pilots when engaging i in brushes on the track, came into existence, is an interesting story harking back to the days of motor paced bicycle racing. It seems that F. Ed Spooner, the noted Detroit automobile and photographer, is the originator of the device, in its application to the gaspline industry.
