A meeting of the world's speed kings took place at the speedway yesterday when Bob Burman, the American champion, and Jules Goux, the Frenchman, shook hands for the first time. Burman holds his title by virtue of the mile he drove in 21.25 seconds at Ormond Beach a couple of years ago, while Goux was awarded his because of his sensational performance on the Brooklands track recently, when he negotiated 106 miles 360 yards in an hour. Burman has thus traveled faster than any other human be-

ing for a mile, while Goux has gone farther than any one before him in an hour.
