CINCINNATI, O., Aug. 27.—Representatives of John J. Ryan, the well-known sporting man, and Barney Oldfield, the automobile racer, met here today and decided to hold a match race between Oldfield and Ryan at Latonia Sept. 12 and 13. Arrangements for the match were agreed upon some time ago, but the death of a man who was struck by Ryan's machine for a time threatened to cause the race to be called off. The match is for \$2,500 a side. A match was also arranged between Walter Christie, New York millionaire, and Charles W. Soules, Oldfield's racing partner, for the same dates.
