## RECORDS ARE BROKEN IN THE ORMOND RACES

**Bernin Drives French Car 100 Miles in  
 1:12:56 1-5, Three Full Minutes  
 Under Old Mark.**

ORMOND, Fla., March 6.—Two records  
 were broken on Ormond beach today. M. G.  
 Bernin, in a sixty-horse-power French car,  
 covered 100 miles in 1:12:56 1-5, almost three  
 full minutes under the old record of 1:15:56  
 1-5; established on Ormond beach in 1906  
 by Walter Clifford in an English car.

The French car today performed con-  
 sistently on every lap and was splendidly  
 driven throughout. The other record to fall  
 was that of the mile for middle weight  
 gasoline cars, Cedrino, in a sixty-horse-  
 power Italian car, covering the distance in  
 35 seconds.

The old record made by Louis Chevrolet  
 in 1906 was 40 3-5 seconds. Bernin made his  
 100-mile record in a special match race  
 against Cedrino's car, S. B. Stevens driving  
 the latter.

The German car's time for the mile, flying  
 start, was 45 3-5 seconds.

The French car made the mile in 39 1-5  
 seconds, while an American car, Stock Cham-  
 sis, fifty-horse-power, covered it in 42 2-5  
 seconds.
