ORMOND, Daytona Beach, Fla., Janu-
ary 31.—Victor Demogeot, of France, was
crowned speed king of the world last
evening on the Daytona sands after driv-
ing his gasoline car two miles in the
marvelous time of 58 4-5 seconds. He
maintained a speed of 123 miles an hour
to make this record.

The two-mile-a-minute race closed the
automobile tournament for this season.
The competition on this event had nar-
rowed down to Marriott, in the steamer,
and to whoever should drive the big 200-
horse power French car. Demogeot was
finally selected.

but the best he could do was 1:02. Demogeot brought the crowd to its feet by reducing the time to 1:01 2-5.

Referee Morrill decided to give each car a trial to see if the time could be brought within the minute. Marriott came first again, and this time faster. He made the two miles in 0:59 3-5.

It seemed impossible that the clumsy-looking French car should reduce this, but the Florida Times-Union \$1,000 trophy was lost to America a few minutes later, when Demogeot thundered over the two-mile course in 0:58 4-5, the fastest speed ever attained by an automobile.

Demogeot was crowned with a laurel wreath by Miss Mary Simrall, of Ormond, Fla., while several thousand persons cheered. An automobile parade followed and this ended the tournament.

The other races of the day were relatively unimportant. The summary follows:

Thirty-mile Championship, American Cars, all Powers—Won by Marriott, forty horsepower steamer. Gross time, 34:18 2-5; actual time, 28:28 2-5; second, Christie, 110 horsepower, gasoline. Time—37:24. Kulick did not finish.

Fifteen-mile Open Championship—Won by Lancia, 110 horsepower gasoline. Time—19:00. Second, Hilliard, 80 horsepower gasoline. Time—11:29 2-5. Cedrino, 110 horsepower gasoline, did not finish.

Ten-mile Open Championship and Ten-mile Heavyweight Championship (run together)—Won by Lancia, 110 horsepower gasoline. Time—4:19 2-5. Second, Marriott, forty horsepower steamer. Time—7:35 2-5.

Ten-mile Open Handicap—Won by Lancia, scratch, 110 horsepower gasoline. Time—6:18 2-5. Second, Hilliard, one minute handicap, eighty horsepower gasoline. Time—5:03 4-5. Harding, two minutes and thirty-four seconds handicap, did not finish.

Two-mile-a-minute Trial—First set won by Demogeot, 200 horsepower gasoline. Time—1:01 2-5. Second, Marriott, forty horsepower steamer. Time—1:02.

Second Set—Won by Demogeot. Time—:58 4-5. Second, Marriott. Time—:59 2-5.

One-mile Middleweight Championship—Won by Gay Vaughn, 100 horsepower gasoline. No time given.
