## FIFTY-MILE RECORD SMASHED

Wallace, in a Darracq Machine, Covers That Distance in 1:1:20 1-5.

PHILADELPHIA, Pa., Nov. 10.-The Darracq machine, driven by E. Wallace, captured the fifty-mile championship here today in the record time of 1 hour, 1 minute, 201-5 seconds. This breaks the track record of Barney Oldfield of 1 hour, 2 minutes.

The Oldsmobile, driven by Ernest Keeler, finished second, and the Pope-Toledo machine, driven by Frank Yeager, was third. For thirty miles the Oldsmobile held the

lead, when the Darracq, by a great spurt, forged shead. This mile was made in the remarkable time of 1 minute. 5 seconds. The only change in positions was on the thirtysixth lap, when the Oldsmobile dropped back to third and then regained second place on the fortieth lap, finishing in second place.

The Oldsmobile broke the twenty-five-mile record in this event. On the back stretch, in the fourth mile, there was a collision, in which a Thomas flyer, driven by Ernest Kelley, was smashed.
