NOTED AUTO DRIVERS ENTER

De Palma, Robertson and Strang to Race at New Los Angeles Track.

NEW YORK, January 8.—F. E. Moskovich, president of the Los Angeles motordrome, the new board track, which is now under construction at Los Angeles, said at the Grand Central Palace automobile show yesterday that he had received the entries of Ralph de Palma, world's track champion; George Robertson, the spectacular road champion, and Louis Strang, the speed king of America. These are the first entries to be received for this course, and all these drivers are confident they will exceed all existing records on the motordrome, which is the first of its kind ever constructed. The first meet will be held on April 10 and will last one week.

Ralph de Palma has recovered from the injuries received at the Danbury track and will drive his reconstructed Cyclone, on which he holds all one-mile circular track records; Strang will drive the 30-horse power Fiat, which holds all world's track records, and Robertson will drive his new Simplex track racer. These drivers should make a wonderful race. It is freely predicted by experts that this will prove to be the most sensational contest ever conducted.

Fred J. Wagner, the famous starter, has been retained to wield the flag and exercise general supervision over the contests. He also will be the eastern representative of the track.
