DETROIT, February 13.—The presence
in Detroit of Alfred Reeves, field secre-
tary of the Association of Licensed Auto-
mobile Manufacturers, has started afresh
the gossip which followed the recent New
York meeting of the association, at which
it was voted to place a fund at Mr.
Reeves's disposal for the purpose of en-
forcing the association's patent rights,
recently passed on favorably by the
court.

That such action will be taken immedi-
ately is not apparent from the work
which Mr. Reeves is now doing. In
fact, it is doubtful if the association is
contemplating any legal action whatever
against established manufacturers of
motor cars.

The Selden patent has but two more
years to run, at the close of which time
a manufacturers' organization, irrespec-
tive of former alliances, will undoubtedly
be formed. Recently four new concerns
were included in the list of makers
whose products are licensed under the
Selden patent. These are Grabovsky
