

Speedway Option Extended to Dec. 15

The option of Indianapolis Voiture No. 145 of the 40 and 8 Society to purchase the Indianapolis Motor Speedway has been extended until Dec. 15, Norman H. Coulon, head of the voiture's Speedway committee, announced yesterday.

Mr. Coulon predicted that "certain legal difficulties will be ironed out soon" and that the proposed transaction will be completed before Dec. 15.

If the voiture obtains ownership of the Speedway, it will arrange for the 500-mile automobile race to be resumed after the end of the war, and for other sporting and entertainment events to be held at the Speedway, Mr. Coulon asserted.

Profits obtained in the operation of the Speedway would be used to help carry forward the child welfare and veteran rehabilitation programs of the American Legion, voiture members have said.
