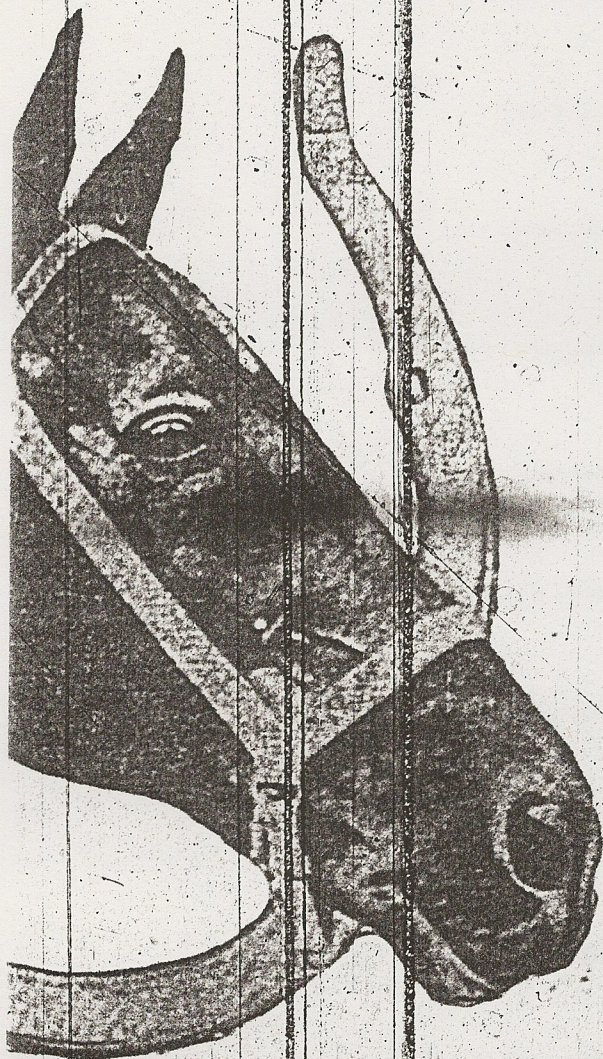

BALLOON INDIANA WILL COMPETE AT SPEEDWAY

BEHAVIOR IN STORM STAMPS FLIER AS GOOD ONE.

IS CHAMPIONSHIP CONTENDER

The big balloon Indiana, which carried George L. Bumbaugh on a wild ride in a heavy rainstorm on Monday evening, will soon be placed in commission again and it will be a candidate for the national championship in the balloon race which the Aero Club of America will conduct at the speedway on September 17. The balloon belongs to Carl G. Fisher and is one of two monster gas bags which Bumbaugh has made for this contest. The balloon was made in the colosseum at the state fair ground and was completed a few days before it was sent on its test flight last Monday.

Bumbaugh is highly pleased with the behavior of the aerial flier in the storm. Since its conduct was admirable under the trying conditions he expects it to make a great showing in the championship race. He and Fisher probably will be its pilots.

Only Fast Ones Wanted.

The purpose of the national event is to eliminate the slower balloons of America for the international race, which will be held in October, in St. Louis, and in the race which starts from the speedway the balloons will be scored both for endurance, or number of hours in the air, and the distance traveled. In the national championship race held at the speedway in June, last year, Fisher's old Indiana was in the air 48½ hours, but was disqualified because the pilots made a landing to get water and then ascended again. The endurance record in that race went to a balloon that was in the air continuously for thirty-five hours.

Five balloons from St. Louis and gas bags from New York, Philadelphia and other cities will bring the total number of contestants in the coming race up to ten or twelve, and as many more are expected to start in the free-for-all, which will leave the speedway as soon as the national candidates are out of the way.
