

# Going After World Records Monday.

"Wild Bob" Burman, the newly crowned "Speed King," will attempt to set new speedway records in his trials at the Speedway Monday morning at 10 o'clock. Barney Oldfield holds the mile Speedway record of the world, made on the Indianapolis Speedway in the "Blitzen" Benz a year ago next Memorial day, but Hemery, the famous Teuton, driving a Benz, holds the kilometer and half-mile marks, making the records on the Brooklands track in England.

Burman lowered the world's straight-away records on Daytona Beach in April, driving the Blitzen Benz, and Monday he is going after the Speedway marks for the quarter, half, mile and kilometer. Burman has been a famous driver for years, and he will probably bring the world's speedway marks to America. On Tuesday Burman will drive a Benz car entered by E. A. Moross in the 500-mile International Sweepstakes race at the Speedway.
