The driver is strapped around the abdomen and the arms are wrapped in tape from the elbows down to give the driver strength to hold the vibrating steering wheel in

a long grind. Then the driver dons a head dress with shields for the ears to guard against breaking the ear drum with the rush of air that comes in traveling at a high rate of speed; gloves, face mask and goggles complete the preparations for the race.
